

- Alicia was a fantastic TA. She was great at explaining concepts, and when we expressed confusion, she worked hard to find new ways to present the information and explain. She's tough in the best way, and willing to engage, and understanding of our circumstances as students. I hope she becomes a professor, because I would love to take courses taught by her.
- Alicia is incredibly dedicated to her work. She works with students as needed and is always there to help them. I was always able to reach her when I was struggling and knew that she would respond quickly to my questions. I am not sure how she was able to do it as a graduate student! She offered me an extension without my having to ask for it because my thesis was due that same week as one of our assignments. Therefore, she is a very relatable TA who is kind and understanding. During each section, she was able to pinpoint the important focus areas and make sure we were well-prepared for assignments. Even when she did not remember something fully, about a question another student would ask, she would fully admit it and send out an email in detail explaining the content. Knowing when to answer and when not to is extremely important and I am very grateful to have had her as a TA!
- Communicated ideas effectively and clearly. Enjoys the material, and wants students to critically engage with material in any way they can. Made the discussion as active as possible. Was a wonderful resource.
- Alicia was an excellent TA. During the discussion sections, she worked to make the material clear and the assignments coherent. 


